What is Christian Youth in Action?

Christian Youth in Action, or CYIA, is a missions program specifically designed for high school and college age students. Training, materials and ministry opportunities are provided to help students confidently share their faith with children in their very own communities. Each year approximately 100 students across SC reach out to nearly 10,000 children throughout the state.

Who conducts CYIA?

What can I expect when I join?

There is an application process. Once approved you will be given dates for required training. Download the free Yapp app or go to the website for specific information and applications. The back of this brochure has helps to get you there.

How will I grow in my relationship with God?

You will discover God's design for you through powerful chapel speakers and encouraging times of worship. Students learn the strength of peer praying and times of personal reflection. It will be a summer unlike any other.



Where is the training held at?



Some of your training will be held at your local CEF office. However, a week-long training school is held at *Columbia International University* in Columbia, South Carolina. CIU is one of the premier missions universities in the world. They believe strongly in the CYIA

program. So much so that they offer tuition discounts to students who serve in CYIA and wish to further their education. There is a cost for your materials, training, meals and lodging. Your local CEF representative will help you discover ways of inviting others to invest in your missions training to help cover some of the expenses.



Who should I expect to serve with?

Students serving in CYIA come from different church backgrounds throughout South Carolina. They are a beautiful blend of color, interests, personalities and talents. Each person who serves has a place to be an encouragement to other students while preparing for the mission to reach children with the Gospel.
