The contest winner receives a four-year scholarship to the South Carolina state-supported institution of his or her choice. The scholarship pays for undergraduate tuition and fees.

To enter, you must be a South Carolina resident aged 16 to 19 years old and a senior in high school. You do not have to have a disability.

Entries must be postmarked no later than February 1, 2016.
