## **CBCCA High School Credential Certificate**

CBCCA is a legal umbrella for homeschool families. CBCCA recognizes that some students with identified disabilities need an alternative option to the high school diploma which allows students to demonstrate their preparedness to transition to the work community. To support these students, CBCCA has developed the High School Credential Certificate. It is designed to contain the same requirements as the credential offered by the South Carolina Public Schools. The purpose of the certificate is to honor the work the students have completed and provide documentation of job-readiness.

Once a student is deemed eligible, through applicable medical assessments, the parents will complete the CBCCA High School Credential Application. This will be submitted along with documentation of the applicable disabilities and the proposed coursework for the upcoming year.

It is important to note, **this certification is not recognized** for admission to colleges and universities. A student may switch to a diploma track of study up to the completion of four semesters of high school.

The four-year coursework must include 24 hours of credit as follows:

- 4 English
- 4 Math
- 2 Science
- 2 Social studies
- 4 Employability Education\*
- 1 PE / Health (or equivalent)
- 1 Technology
- 6 Electives

Employability education includes the following skills:

- Problem-solving skills
- Teamwork and collaboration skills
- Communication skills
- Leadership
- Initiative
- Flexibility and adaptability
- Interpersonal skills

There are several resources online to guide parents in finding and/or developing curriculum.
