I, _____ understand that I am agreeing to the following standards for the Community Bible Church Upper School Co-Op. My participation is completely voluntary and I understand that my family can be removed or dismissed for any reason from Community Bible Church Upper School Co-Op.

Parent initials _____ I acknowledge that I am still the primary teacher of the student.

Parent initials _____ I am responsible for my student's regular attendance at Co-Op. Students are not allowed to leave campus during recess unless they are leaving for the day. Anyone leaving and coming back must have an Off-Campus Authorization Form in order to leave campus signed by the parent or guardian.

Parent initials _____ I am responsible that my student has the tools that they need to be successful. Students will need to have access to Google Classroom, Band App and a stable internet connection to keep up with assignments, join discussion boards and communicate with their instructors. They also need to have the books assigned to them.

Parent initials _____ It is my responsibility to prepare and train my student(s) to take responsibility for their own work as well as help them make sure they are prepared for class with their assigned work.

Parent initials _____ I am ultimately responsible for keeping track of student grades with input of co-op tutors.

Parent initials _____ I understand that I am responsible for the fees for labs and to purchase required curriculum for co-op, although we try to keep the financial commitment to a minimum.

Parent initials _____ I understand that students may not bring their phones inside the building to Co-Op unless they are checked in at Study Hall. Any student with their phone will have it taken.

Parent initials _____ I am responsible to make sure that my student follows the rules outlined in the CBC Upper School Handbook and that they are respectful to their fellow students and to their instructors.

Parent initials _____ I am responsible for downloading the Band App and monitoring my student's assignments on Google Classroom. I understand that teachers should not be responsible for student questions just before co-op or late the night before. Teachers will do their best to assist, but they are volunteers and also have families that they are responsible for. Most questions can be answered with the handbook, Band or Google Classroom.

Parent initials _____ I will go to the teacher first, respectfully, knowing that there are two sides of every conflict if there is a question about the work or behavior of my student or a conflict in the classroom. If it cannot be resolved, I will talk to co-op administrative leads.

Parent initials _____ I agree that I am responsible to make sure that my student follows the dress code. Dress Code: No tight shirts, plunging necklines, cropped shirts, halter tops or spaghetti straps. No inappropriate, obscene or objectionable t-shirts. No undergarments may be showing. No shorts. Jeans, pants, khakis, skirts past knees etc. are fine. Leggings with shirts that are long and cover your bottom are also fine. Students will be warned and asked to change. Continued non-compliance with dress code will result in dismissal from co-op.

Parent initials _____ I understand that in order to participate in co-op, I must help teach, monitor classes or hallways as much as my season of life allows. If I have younger students that commitment may be fulfilled on Tuesdays when the younger co-op also meets.

Student Responsibilities

I, _____ understand that I am agreeing to the following standards for the Community Bible Church Upper School Co-Op. My participation in this Co-Op is completely voluntary and I understand that I can be removed or dismissed for any reason from Community Bible Church Upper School Co-Op.

Student initials _____ I understand that students do not have access to cell phones at co-op. It must stay in the car or be checked in at Study Hall. Any student with their phone will have it taken.

Student initials _____ Download and use Google Classroom and Band to keep up with assignments. Attend class and participate in homework, long term assignments as well as classroom work and discussions.

Student initials _____ Students are responsible for doing assigned work during the time they are out of class. It will be very difficult to keep up if a student misses classes and does not keep up with assignments. Work submission is up to individual instructors, but all homework will be posted on Google Classroom so there should be no reason for students to miss work. If there are extraordinary circumstances, extensions on work are given at the discretion of the instructor. Students who miss ten assignments or more will no longer be academically eligible and will be dropped from class.

Student initials _____ Students should be attentive and respectful to the instructor as well as respectful of other students. Disruptions in class that keep other students from learning are unacceptable. A verbal warning will be given, but students will be dismissed from class if behavior persists. Continued misbehavior will result in dismissal from co-op.

Student initials _____ I agree that I am responsible follow the dress code. **Dress Code:** No tight shirts, plunging necklines, cropped shirts, halter tops or spaghetti straps. No inappropriate, obscene or objectionable t-shirts. No undergarments may be showing. No shorts. Jeans, pants, khakis, skirts past knees etc. are fine. Leggings with shirts that are long and cover your bottom are also fine. Students will be warned and asked to change. Continued non-compliance with dress code will result in dismissal from co-op.

Student initials _____ I will remain in the Children's Building and will not be unsupervised in the church building. Lunch will be in the Fellowship Hall or outside unless weather is inclement or another circumstance prevents going outside.

Student initials _____ No kitchen use at co-op. Pack a lunch that does not need to be heated.

Student initials _____ I understand that I am expected to help with set up, tear down and clean up. Students need to stay and help clean up or come early to set up.

Student initials _____ I understand that students must sign out of co-op if leaving before the end of their school day if they are not being taken by their parents. The sign out sheet will be in the Study Hall at the Admin Desk (Ms. Lucy's Desk). If leaving and coming back, they must sign back in. Students are not allowed to leave campus during recess unless they are leaving for the day.
